a. <u>Internship Program</u>

Date: Ongoing

Participants: WMMR, WBEN, WXTU

The Employment Unit conducted an internship program designed to assist members of the community in acquiring skills necessary for broadcast employment. Interns came from various universities in the Philadelphia area. A typical day had the students join the On-Air Personalities as they kicked off their workday. They were instructed on how to log show notes, pull airchecks for the Sales Department and create research sheets on upcoming show guests. The program hosted 18 students during the reporting period.
